

A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE

Sapatgram College is the only institution of higher education in this highly backward area of western Assam. It was started at the initiative of some local people interested in dissemination of higher education in this economically backward area. The college came into existence as a result of the untiring efforts and sacrifices of some of the leading personalities of the area like Late Panchanan Badhuri, Late Panchanan Medhi, Late Indubhusan Bhadra, Late Sunilal Narzary, Sri Santosh Kumar Dutta, Sri Samar Kanti Poit, Mr. P.K. Das, Mr A. Bhaduri, Mr Pabitra Kr. Das, Sri Ranajit Saha, Md. Sirajuddin Ahmed and others.

Initially the college functioned from the Kachari building of the Zamindar of Parbatjoar situated in Ward No. 1 of Sapatgram Town on the 7th August 1972. Later on, it was shifted to its present site. Then Late Lilananda Thakur (commonly known as Pagal Baba) donated a building along with 1 (one) bigha of land to the College which helped the college a lot in the initial period. The College is, at present, spread over an area of 25 (twenty five) bighas of land in the Sonamoyee Gaon Panchayat on the banks of the river Loska, allotted to the College by the Government of Assam. The College was accorded affiliation by Gauhati University in 1980-81. Subsequently, it was brought under the Deficit Grants- in- Aid system on the 1st September 1983 due to the active help of Late Ranendra Narayan Basumatary, Ex-Cabinet Minister of Assam. The College was recognized by the University Grants Commission under Section 2(f) and 12 (B) of the UGC Act, 1956 in July, 2002. In December, 2004 the college was assessed by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council, Bangalore and was accorded the grade C++. The College came under Provincialisation Act from 1st December 2005. Conforming to the National Pattern of Education (10+2+3 system), this full-fledged Degree College imparts two- year Higher Secondary and three- year Degree courses of studies in Arts stream and one year Regular PGDCA Course. The college has undergone the 2nd cycle of assessment by NAAC, Bangalore and has been accorded the Grade 'B' with CGPA 2.52 in February, 2016.

The College was under the stewardship of a number of educationists and administrators at different times. Sri R.K. Sharma was the founder Principal of the College. After him Sri R.N. Pandey took over the administration of the College as Principal. The great scholar and renowned economist, Dr B.P Mishra, was the Principal of the College from 4.9.1981 to 21.4.1982. Sri S.P Mukherjee remained the Principal i/c from time to time. Sri A. K Sengupta remained the Principal i/c for a short period. Sri. D. Sarkar joined the College as Principal on 1.4.1984 and continued up to 30.11.1996. Sri S.P. Mukherjee again became the Principal i/c till 30.5.99. Sri N. Roy remained the Principal i/c from 1.6.99 upto 1st August 2005. Dr T. K. Sarmah joined the College as Principal on 2nd August 2005 and continued up to 29.2.2016. Mr. S. K. Panigrahi became the Principal i/c on 1.3.2016.

 The vision of Sapatgram College is to transform this institution into a centre of excellence of higher learning by continuous working towards making education socially relevant and meaningful.

Admission Process:

How to Apply:

Before the beginning of the academic session the Principal generally notifies the date for collection and submission of application forms on the college Notice Board and in the college website (sapatgramcollege.org). The college does not entertain applications for admission received after the last date of submission. The applicants have to submit attested copies of relevant certificates along with the applications. Incomplete forms are rejected. A Prospectus is supplied along with the application form. Applicants have to bring original certificates for verification at the time of admission.



Selection Procedure:

Students seeking admission have to present themselves before the selection committee as per dates to be notified. Selection is made on the basis of merit and personal interview. A list of the selected candidates for admission is notified on the college notice board.

Reservation of Seats:

There is a provision for reservation of seats belonging to S.C, S.T(P), S. T (H), O.B.C. and M. O.B. C. categories as per Government Rules. The candidates have to produce valid certificates issued by the competent authorities.

Attendance Rules in Classes

Attendance of students in class lectures, tutorial classes is compulsory. Students attending individual classes up to 75% or above in the H.S. (both 1st and 2nd Year) classes are only allowed to appear as regular candidates in A.H.S.E.C. Examinations. The students attending individual classes up to 75% or above in B.A. 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th & 6th Semesters are only allowed to appear as regular candidate at the Gauhati University Examinations. For Private candidates specific University regulations are applicable.

Teaching and Evaluation

The College follows the academic calendars of G.U. and A.H.S.E.C. for B.A. and H.S. courses respectively. Besides, the college has got its own academic calendar showing total working days, teaching days and date and time for various examinations. The academic year commences from the month of July.

In addition to normal classroom teaching, the college imparts teaching by organizing Departmental Seminars and tutorial classes.



The evaluation process in continuous and is based on the students' progress in home assignments, unit tests, laboratory work (for the students of Major in Education) field work, examinations and internal assessments.

Discipline

The students admitted to the college must abide by the rules and regulations of the college. Violation of rules, irregular attendance, non-payment of college dues and fees, showing discourtesy to the teachers and employees in any form, ragging, adoption of unfair means during examinations, causing damage to the college property, smoking, taking alcohol and intoxication drugs within the campus or in public places are some of the offences which may make a student liable for disciplinary action, viz, forced transfer, termination of scholarship and even expulsion from the college. Use of mobile phones in the college campus is strictly prohibited.

Uniform

The students admitted to the college must wear college uniform during class hours, in the examination hall and during all other college activities such as seminars, college week, extension activities and so on. The College Uniform is as follows:

FACILITIES

Central Library:

Central Library, Sapatgram College has been trying its best to provide efficient service to the readers. The Library has been aiming at supplementing the knowledge of the students which they acquire from their teachers. Central Library, Sapatgram College is well stocked with more than 17000 texts and reference books, more than a dozen of local and national journals and a few newspapers and other information sources like maps, globes CD-ROMs etc. It is situated on the 1st floor of the Administrative Building with a Reading Hall for students and a Reading Room for teachers. The library follows open access system and it remains open from 9:30 AM to 4:30 PM on the working days.

Class Rooms:

21 classrooms, both big and small, are available for taking theoretical and Education Major Practical Classes. There are 10 large Class Rooms for Higher Secondary classes and Degree Course General Classes, 10 small Class Rooms for Degree Major and Practical Classes and 1 Smart Class Room

Indoor Stadium cum Auditorium:

The college has built an Indoor Stadium with UGC grant having provision for Badminton, Volleyball and other indoor games. The gallery can accommodate more than 700 audience. In the absence of an auditorium, the Indoor Stadium is being used as an Auditorium. There is a large stage in the building and as an auditorium it can accommodate more than 1500 audience.

Students' Common Room:

There are separate Common Rooms for boys and girls with adequate toilet facilities and indoor games like table tennis, carom, chess etc. The Girls' Common Room is situated on the 2nd Floor of the Administrative Building with the provision of running water in the toilets and filtered drinking water. The Boys' Common Room is situated adjacent to the small class rooms with toilet facility with running water. Filters have been provided there for drinking water.

Women's Hostel:

Sapatgram College has a Women's Hostel constructed with the UGC grants in two phases. The Women's Hostel is situated within the college campus in a healthy and secured environment. It is adjacent to the Principal's Quarter. The hostel has its own set of rules and regulations which are strictly mandatory for all the boarders. Students are encouraged to practise yoga in the hostel in the evening. One Yoga teacher teaches them the fundamentals of yoga every Sunday morning. This helps the boarders to concentrate their minds to devote for learning.

The Women's Hostel, Sapatgram College has a strong and effective administrative base comprising the following members:

Hostel Admission:

Regular hostel admission is done at the time of admission in college of each academic session. Students are selected strictly on the basis of merit. However, the reservation policy for SC/ST/OBC category students is strictly maintained.

• Drinking Water:

The college has taken adequate steps to provide safe drinking water to the students. There are online ultraviolet water purifiers in the Girls' Common Room, Central Library and Teachers' Common Room. Besides, a water cooler fitted to an online ultraviolet water purifier has been put for the use of all under the staircase of the Administrative Building. This comes as a boon to the students during the summer.

Toilets:

The college has provided toilets in Girls' Common Room and Boys' Common Room. Besides, there is a separate toilet for boys. There are toilets in the Teachers' Common Room, Principal's Room, Conference Room for teachers, Conference Hall, the Central Library and the Office Room. The toilet in the Central Library is specifically meant for the female teachers and staff. All the toilets are cleaned regularly by a sweeper appointed by the college.

• Canteen:

College canteen remains open from 9am to 5pm. It is under the supervision of a contractor who is generally an ex-student of this college. There is a Canteen Supervisory Cell which looks after the smooth running of the canteen, regulates the prices of food items and inspects the quality of the food items. The canteen has separate sitting arrangement for students and teachers.

Internet:

Internet facility has been provided to the students and teachers in the Central Library, Network Resource Centre and the Computer Centre of the college. There are 3 computers in the Central Library, 2 computers in the Network Resource Centre and 4 computers in the Computer Centre with internet facility which remain open to the students and teachers from 9.00 A.M to 4.30 P.M. The browsing and downloading in these computers are free of cost.



Sports Activity:

The college has its athletics and sports equipments. One part time qualified Physical Education Teacher has been appointed to train the students in football, volleyball, cricket, gymnastics, high jump, long jump and other games and sports activities. The Indoor Games are conducted in the Mini Indoor Stadium.

Study Tour: The Departments organize Study Tours for their students to places of historical, cultural and educational importance. The college organizes an environmental Study Tour for the students of 4th Semester as part of their syllabus of Environmental Studies. In such study tours the male and female teachers of the college accompany the students for maintaining discipline among them and to elaborate the historical/ cultural/environmental significance of the places visited.

Literary Activity:

Sapatgram College Magazine is published annually. It publishes the literary writings, views and opinions of students and teachers. Some of the Departments have their Wall Magazines which carry the poems, articles, cartoons and paintings of the students. Some of the Departments publish their Annual Journals which contain the research papers of the students presented in the Seminar Classes. All such efforts are aimed at bringing out the latent creative and critical talent in the budding students.

Quiz and Debate:

There is a Debating Society in the college which organizes debates, extempore speeches and quiz competitions among the students from time to time and prizes are given to the winners on the Final Day Function of the College Week. All such activities are conducted with an aim of bringing out the latent talent in the students. The students of the college have won prizes in the quiz and debate competitions held at the sub-divisional and district levels by the Govt. of Assam.

Music and Dance:

Music and dance are encouraged by the college. Of course, these are not actively promoted by the college because of lack of space and time. Competitions of music and dance are conducted during the College Week and the winners are awarded prizes and certificates on the Final Day Function of the College Week. The recognized singers and dancers are encouraged to perform in different meetings, workshops, seminars and functions of the college. Thus such talent is recognized by the college.

Scouts and Guides:

Scouts and Guides was introduced in the college in 2004. The boys are encouraged to join Scouts as Rovers and the girls are encouraged to join Guides as Rangers. Dr. Padma Guha Agarwala, Associate Professor, is the Ranger Leader (H.W.B) and Mr. Abdul Rezzak Sheikh, Assistant Professor, is the Rover Leader. The main motto of Scouts and Guides is to build the students as good citizens by inculcating in them the sense of discipline, sense of self-sufficiency and the value of dignity of labour. The physical activities help the students in shaping their physical health and the cultural activities bring out the latent talent in them. The



Rangers and Rovers of the college are engaged in maintaining discipline, law and order in the functions in the college and also in the meetings, and functions in the neighbouring areas. Miss Nur Akhtara Begum and Ms. Gitarani Kalita were awarded the Rashtrapati Award for Ranger Testing conducted by the National Headquarter, Bharat Scouts and Guides, New Delhi in 2010. They received awards from Mrs. Pratibha Devi Singh Patil, Hon'ble President of India at Rashtrapati Bhavan in 2011. Sri Ratan Roy won the third prize in the Quiz Competition held in the North East Regional Tribal Scouts and Guides Meet at State Training Centre, Agartala, Tripura from 9th to 13th September, 2013.

National Service Scheme:

NSS has been introduced in the college from the academic session 2015-16. 100 students of the college have joined it as volunteers.

<u>Students' Union:</u>

Sapatgram College Students' Union Council is the elected body of representatives of the students. Each year the election to the posts of Vice-President, General Secretary, Asst. General Secretary, Secretary-Major Games, Secretary-Minor Games, Secretary-Debate & Culture, Social Service Secretary, Secretary-Boys' Common Room and Secretary-Girls' Common Room of SCSUC is held in the month of September and the elected representatives assume office and remain in power for one year, i.e. up to the newly elected representatives assume office. The Principal is the President of SCSUC. Teachers are appointed as Professor In-Charge against different portfolios and the Secretaries perform their activities under the active supervision of the teachers.

Recreation:

The college takes steps in organizing music and dance shows by the students and by experts from outside. Prominent folk- singers are invited to perform before students in order to inculcate in the students a love for their own cultural heritage.

Discipline:

The college believes that the objective of imparting education to the students and thus transform them into good citizens can be achieved only in a conducive atmosphere for such activities. In that case, the students have to be highly disciplined and punctual. Hence, the college maintains discipline in the campus. A Grade-IV employee at the entry gate does not allow the students without uniform and Identity Card to enter the campus. This is done in order to check the entry of trouble shooters. Any kind of indiscipline in the classroom and in the campus is strictly dealt with. The Class Management and Academic Atmosphere Supervisory Cell takes active steps in this regard.

Students' Aid Fund:

Applications are invited from poor and meritorious students at the beginning of every academic session which are scrutinized by the Students' Aid Fund Committee and scholarships are given to the deserving students on the basis of merit out of the collection of Students' Aid Fund.



Departmental Rooms:

All the Departments have been provided separate Departmental Rooms in the Old Building as well as in the New Building. Computers have been provided to most of the Departments and the computers in the newly constructed Teachers' Common Room have been provided Internet facility.

Career Counseling Cell:

Counselling of students in the choice of subjects in General and Major Courses during admission and in $the \ choice \ of \ career \ options \ to \ fresh \ graduates \ is \ an \ important \ aspect \ of \ every \ institution \ of \ higher \ education.$ Sapatgram College has a Career Counselling Cell which organizes counselling of students before admission regarding choice of subjects in General and Major Courses. It also organizes seminars and workshops in career counselling of fresh graduates regarding career options. Mr. Indranil Sarkar, Associate Professor and Head of the Department of English, is the Coordinator of the Career Counselling Cell.

Staff Quarters:

The Principal's Quarters have been built with UGC grant in the college campus. There is a plan to build some staff quarters.

Communicative English:

The Department of English conducts a 3 month Certificate Course in Communicative English for the interested students. The classes are conducted by the faculty of the Department after regular classes and on Sundays and holidays. The students have to pay only a Registration fee of Rs.200/- for the course which is utilized for purchase of study materials and stationery expenditure. The course is conducted twice in a year and 20 students are selected on the basis of merit and aptitude for each course. Mr. Indranil Sarkar, Associate Professor and Head of the Department of English, is the Coordinator of the Certificate Course.

Computer Centre:

The Computer Centre, situated on the 2nd floor of the Administrative Building, conducts a number of computer courses in collaboration with Third Eye Education. The Basic Course in Computer Application has been made compulsory for H.S 1st Year students since 2008-09 academic session. The certificates to the successful students are given by the college. There are other courses such as Certificate Course in Computer Application (6 months), PGDCA(Regular) (1 year) under Gauhati University, and Diploma in Accounts & Finance (6 months) conducted by Third Eye Education. At present there are 20 computers in the Computer Centre.

Grievance Redressal Cell:

The Grievance Redressal Cell, Sapatgram College remains active throughout the year and remains more vigilant at the commencement of every academic session in order to prevent any kind of ragging of the freshers. There is a Grievance Box in front of the Principal's Office which is opened at 4.00 P.M every day. The Principal, who is the Convener of the Cell, holds a meeting of the cell to discuss the grievances received and the cell tries to redress the grievances of the students.



Smart Class Room:

The Smart Class Room has been constructed in the college with the grant from State Government in 2015-16. Some of the classes are held in this room where interactive sessions are held. Such things have immensely benefited the students.

Guest House:

The college has constructed a Guest House out of the UGC grants. The Guest House was a necessity of the college in this rural area.

Post Graduate Correspondence School:

The college has the facility of distance learning by its study centres of IDOL & KKHSOU. The courses offered are Post Graduate course in English, Assamese, Bengali, Political Science, Economics, History, Mathematics and Sanskrit. The Post Graduate Diploma Course in Sales & Marketing Management and Human Resource Management are also offered in these study centres.


